ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS



In a visionary move towards a greener and more sustainable future, the Town of Legal has completed the installation of two Level 2 electric vehicle charging stations (EVCS) that are available for public use; one located at the Legal Arena (4720 51 Ave) and the other located at the Town of Legal Municipal Office (5021 50 St). A third Level 2 electric vehicle charging station was also installed at the Municipal Shop for municipal use of future fleet electric vehicles (EV). The installation is poised to make a significant impact on the community, addressing the growing need for accessible EV infrastructure in rural Alberta.

These chargers were generously funded in part by the Government of Alberta and Natural Resources Canada through the Electric Vehicle Charging Program (EVCP), administered by the Municipal Climate Change Action Centre (MCCAC).

A special thanks to everyone who championed this project, and who supported the installation and funding application for the chargers.

The Municipal Climate Change Action Centre is a partnership of Alberta Municipalities, the Rural Municipalities of Alberta, and the Government of Alberta. Funding for the Electric Vehicle Charging Program was provided by the Government of Alberta and Natural Resources Canada.

WINTER REMINDERS! Please keep the following in mind:

- ❄️ **It is your responsibility to clear your sidewalks of snow, ice and debris within 48 hours of a snowfall.** Do not put snow removed from your property onto roadways or neighboring properties. Failure to do so could result in a \$250 fine for a first offence.
- ❄️ **Remove curb ramps from roads.** The Town will not be responsible for damages.
- ❄️ **Stay off the surface of the fishing pond.** It's not safe anytime during the winter for skating, fishing, or walking.
- ❄️ **Remove vehicles from roads after a snowfall.** This allows equipment to clean streets safely and without obstructions.

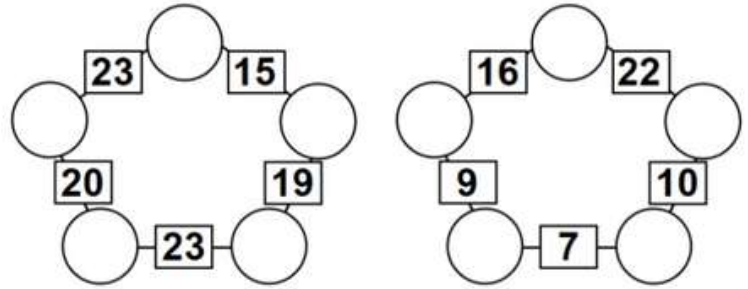

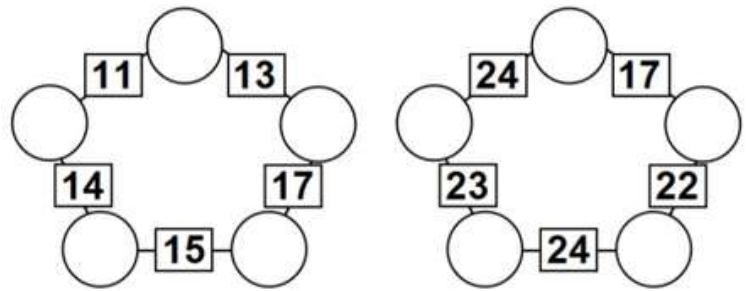
ARITHMAGON

It's Winter "snowflake" Sudoku

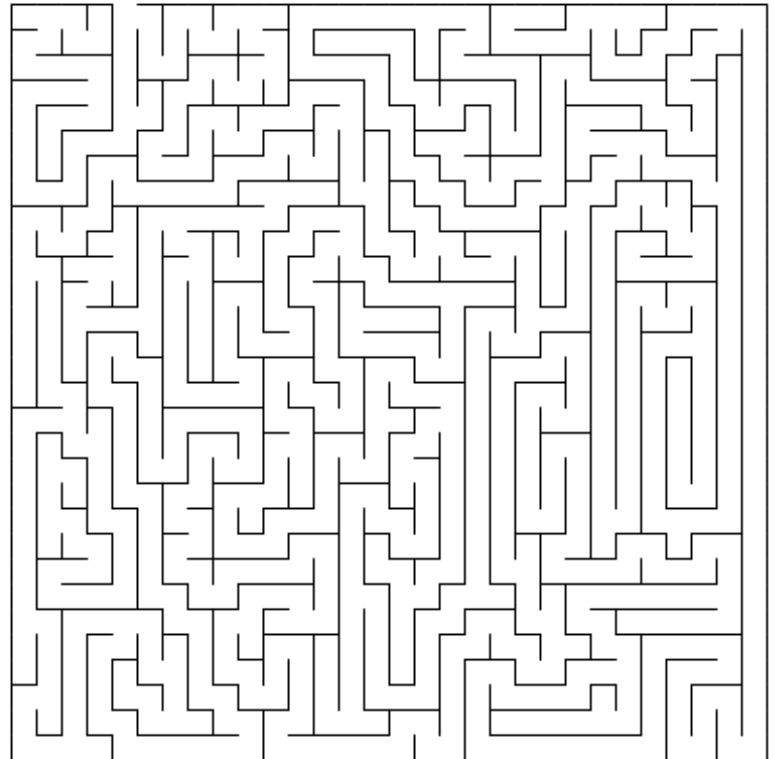

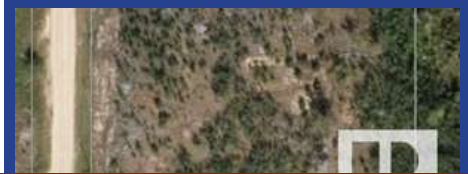
