In 1983, a group of community minded neighbours banded together and became the "eyes and ears" of their Sturgeon community. These pioneers realized that

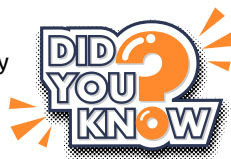
our RCMP members could not be everywhere and cover the 2300 square kms of farmland, towns, villages, hamlets and the countless acreage sub-divisions that were growing rapidly. They had the vision to lay the foundation of our community crime prevention organization.

Our first charter was signed off by Bernie Prefontaine, Mitch Zachcaruk, William Mitchell, Way Potter, Roland Tieulie, and co-signed by RCMP member Cst. J.M. Michaud. Bernie became our first association president followed by William Mitchell, Ray Kremer, Cal Putnam, Henry Bergstreiser, Pat Plesma, Jim Eddleston, Emile Cloutier, Jerry Belziuk, Shawn Viney, Richard DeChamplain, Margaret Romanowski, Roger Nykipilo, Francoise Meunier, Bonny Swart-Attwood, Viviane Pezer (acting), Michelle Addo, and currently Colleen Prefontaine (acting).

Originally the SRCWA did not serve the entire county but reflected that of the area covered by the Morinville RCMP Detachment. Following a vote to expand our boundaries to include ALL of Sturgeon County, SCRWA President, Michelle Addo, and Redwater & District RCWA President, Shirley Vice, signed the documents finalizing the change on May 30, 2022. Our Association now covers the entire County of Sturgeon and is divided into 6 Zones (formally 16) which correspond to the County Divisions. We have been slowly working on the challenging task of updating the 800 plus membership list to reflect these changes.

The SRCWA Board has been working closely with Councillors and Protective Services of the County of Sturgeon as well as maintaining a relationship with the RCMP Detachments and K Division Headquarters. At these regular meetings, we discuss promoting crime prevention through awareness, education and encouraging reporting of suspicious activity when observed. For example, the RAVE & CAPTURE appS. These applications allow on-line reporting of a crime & the sharing of remote camera images and videos with the RCMP.

As we slowly recover from the effects of the lockdowns, the association has been actively participating in Parades (Bon Accord, Gibbons, Legal, Redwater), Wellness On Wells (WOW) events and the Candy Cane Check Stop in Morinville. We were also visible at several Crime Prevention Seminars and the RCMP 150 Celebrations in both Redwater and Morinville. This year in February, we hosted the Zone 5 - AGM & Symposium (featuring presentations on Bullying, CAPTURE, Property Owner Rights and Human Trafficking) in Riviera Qui Barre. Invitations were sent to all members on our email list. On March 19, we will be holding our AGM at the Cultural Centre in Gibbons. We will have a speaker from the RCMP followed by a short meeting and elections.



In 1995, the Alberta Provincial Rural Crime Watch Association (www.ruralcrimewatch.ab.ca) became the umbrella organization for Member Crime Watch Associations and is divided into Zones 1 to 5. The SRCWA is in Zone 5 alongside Barrhead

Geographic Information Systems (GIS) Technician (12 Weeks)

Under the direction of the CAO and Public Works Supervisor, the employee will be responsible for spatial and data collection for Town owned water and sewer systems, sidewalk and roads and other associated appurtenances. Data collected will be used to verify that current information entered in the Town's Geographical Information System (GIS) is accurate. Additional data collected which does not form part of the current GIS System will be entered accordingly .

Responsibilities: Collecting spatial data including latitude and longitude coordinates, reviewing current as-build drawings, contacting and requesting digital files from electrical, gas, and telecom utility providers, contacting Town Engineers to acquire information on an as need basis, requesting information from municipal neighbours which the Town provides or has agreements to supply water servicing, engaging routinely with Town utility operators to develop spreadsheets that will enable utility operators and Public Works staff the ability to enhance services and better track infrastructure performance, repairs and upgrades. Must be capable of working independently or with a team. The position requires an outdoor and indoor environment and safety is of utmost importance. The applicant must have basic knowledge in water and wastewater systems, road infrastructure, Geographical information Systems and be proficient computer systems .

Duration: 12 Weeks (35 hours weekly) June 3 to August 25, 2024

Applicants must have a strong work ethic and motivation, a current valid driver's license. Priority will be given to those with strong computer skills experience or training relating to asset management.

Maintenance Labourer - Public Works (16 Weeks)

Under the direction of the Public Works Supervisor, the employee will be responsible for duties related to water sewer systems, road maintenance and building facilities.

Responsibilities: operation of light vehicles, small commercial tractors, tools and other specialized maintenance tools and equipment, minor road repair, crack sealing, crosswalk painting, pothole & sidewalk repairs, inspection and inventory, hydrant inspections & painting, exercising of water valves, minor repairs to buildings, inputting data on the asset management system and other related duties as assigned.

Duration: 16 Weeks (35 hours weekly) May 8 to August 25, 2024

Applicants must have a strong work ethic and motivation, a current valid driver's license. Priority will be given to those with experience relating to the position, and willing to obtain relevant training.

Maintenance Worker - Parks (16 Weeks)

Town of Legal Municipal Development Plan & Land Use Bylaw

Project Newsletter #1 | March 2024

HELLO!

The Town is embarking on an important project; updating the Town's Municipal Development Plan and Land Use Bylaw. The purpose of this newsletter is to provide residents with information about the project and to identify future opportunities for community members to get involved.

WHAT IS A MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN?

A Municipal Development Plan is required for all municipalities in Alberta that establishes a plan for managing growth and encouraging development that support the community's unique heritage and goals for the future.

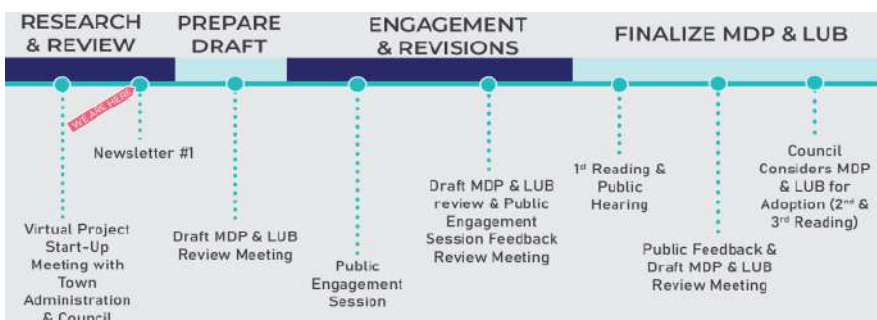
Once the new Municipal Development Plan is complete and adopted by Council, the Plan will guide decisions made by Council and the Town's approving authorities effecting community services, recreation, economic development, ecosystem services and municipal infrastructure.

WHAT IS A LAND USE BYLAW?

The Land Use Bylaw establishes regulations to guide how land is used and developed. It divides a municipality into different districts (or 'zones') on a map, and identifies what uses are permitted or discretionary for each district. The Land Use Bylaw includes procedures for submitting, processing, and deciding upon subdivision and development applications. For some specific land use activities, regulations are included to provide further clarity on how they may be developed in the municipality.

The purpose of a Land Use Bylaw is to separate uses that might conflict with each other, and to protect property owners and residents from uses that may negatively impact the use and enjoyment of their property. The Land Use Bylaw supports the Town's economic and community development goals and objectives established in the Municipal Development Plan.

After the Open House and community members have shared their comments and input via the Feedback Survey, Municipal Planning Services will compile and summarize all feedback received from community members into a What We Heard Report. The Report will be posted on the Town's website for community members to review and shared with the Town Council.
