BUSINESS LICENSES

Reminder to purchase your 2026 Town of Legal Business License at the Town Office BEFORE February 15.

A 10% discount will be applied to any Town of Legal Business License purchased prior to February 15. Visit www.legal.ca for Business License Fees.

LANDFILL PASS

Legal residents are reminded to purchase or reactivate your 2026 Roseridge Residential Landfill Permit at the Town Office BEFORE going to the landfill.

ANNUAL FEE: \$5.00 = 1,000kg for the calendar year (Jan. 1 to Dec. 31)

2026 OVERAGE FEES:

FOR WEIGHTS BETWEEN 1,001KG TO 2,500KG:

\$45.96 / 1,000kg will be charged on January's utility bill of the following year.

FOR WEIGHTS 2,501KG AND OVER:

Fees specified by Roseridge Waste Management Services Commission will be charged directly to the user by Roseridge Waste Management Services Commission on location at the waste disposal site at the time of waste disposal.

WINTER REMINDERS!

Please keep the following in mind:

- ✿ **IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CLEAR YOUR SIDEWALKS OF SNOW, ICE & DEBRIS WITHIN 48 HOURS OF A SNOWFALL.** Do not put snow removed from your property onto roadways or neighboring properties. Failure to do any of the above could result in a \$250 fine for a first offence.
- ✿ **REMOVE VEHICLES FROM ROADS AFTER A SNOWFALL.** This allows Town equipment to clean streets safely and without obstructions.
- ✿ **REMOVE CURB RAMPS FROM ROADS.** The Town will not be responsible for damages to curb ramps left out.
- ✿ **STAY OFF THE SURFACE OF THE FISHING POND.** It's not safe anytime during the winter for skating, fishing, or walking.


