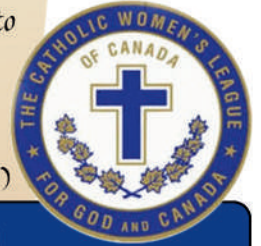

The Town is currently seeking a full-time, Seasonal Maintenance Labourer and a full-time Seasonal Maintenance Labourer to join our team.

The term of these positions will be from May 4, 2026 to August 28, 2026.



### Seasonal Maintenance Labourer

**Responsibilities:** Maintenance and landscaping on Town owned parks and sports fields; operation of light vehicles, small commercial tractors, tools and other specialized maintenance tools and equipment, minor road repair, crack sealing, crosswalk painting, pothole & sidewalk repairs; inspection and inventory, hydrant inspections & painting; exercising of water valves; minor repairs to buildings; other related duties as assigned.

### Seasonal Parks Maintenance Worker

**Responsibilities:** Maintenance and landscaping on Town owned parks and sports fields; operation of light vehicles, small commercial tractors, tools and other specialized maintenance tools and equipment; minor road repair, crack sealing, crosswalk painting, pothole & sidewalk repairs; inspection and inventory, hydrant inspections & painting; Exercising of water valves; minor repairs to buildings; operation of light vehicles, commercial mowers, tractors, small cutting/hedge trimming machinery, power tools and other specialized seasonal maintenance equipment; grass cutting, landscaping, watering; fence repairs, inspection of playground equipment; painting, signage, carpentry; assist with construction & landscaping projects; maintenance of light equipment & mowers, horticulturist/arborist duties; other related duties as assigned

### Qualifications

- A valid Alberta Class 5 Drivers License is required.
- Completion of Grade 11 (equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered).
- Physical ability and dexterity to perform a variety of manual tasks including heavy lifting, squatting, bending, twisting, and climbing (work is performed with exposure to outdoor elements).
- Strong work ethic and motivation
- Ability to communicate courteously and effectively with supervisors, coworkers, and the public.
- Good functioning reading, writing, and mathematical skills.
- Knowledge and previous experience related to municipal maintenance operations is an asset.
- The successful candidate will be required to provide a Criminal Record Check and Drivers Abstract Consent as a condition of employment.

These positions are partially funded by the Canada Summer Jobs grant program and requires applicants to meet the following eligibility:

- applicants must be between 15-30 years of age, and either a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred (foreign students are ineligible) and be legally entitled to work in Canada.

Compensation/Hours of Work: This position has a starting wage of \$21.50 per hour based on a 35-hour work week.

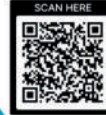
- **Property Crime:** to reduce property crime by targeting high risk known offenders and other related criminal activities.

## BLACK KNOT TREE FUNGUS - HOW TO GET RID OF IT



Black Knot is a fungus that can kill a tree in a few years if it's not handled. It is a greenish knot or elongated swelling that forms on twigs and branches and can develop into a black, corky mass that range from about 0.5" to 1.5" in size and may be more than 12" long. You can save your trees by pruning the infected branches. Burn, or wrap the branches in plastic and throw them away in the regular garbage. **DO NOT bring them to the Compost Site.**
