Just outside of Legal in Sturgeon County, a family-run farm is quietly transforming the local landscape, one bloom at a time. Forcade Farms, operated by Yanick and Danielle Forcade alongside their daughters, fondly known as the “interns”, is bringing fresh, locally grown flowers to the region while continuing a proud fourth-generation farming tradition.

While the Forcade family has long been rooted in grain farming, a new chapter began in 2021 with the planting of thousands of peonies. What started as a passion project quickly blossomed into a thriving cut flower operation. The farm is truly a multi-generational effort, as they work alongside Yanick’s parents, Marie and Louis Forcade, who have deep roots in the Legal community.

Today, Forcade Farms cultivates a stunning variety of blooms including peonies, dahlias, gladiolus, and other specialty flowers, offering a vibrant, locally grown alternative to imported floral products.

During the growing season, their flowers can be found in select flower shops throughout Edmonton and St. Albert. This June marks an exciting new offering: a monthly bouquet subscription with convenient pick-up at Heidi’s Haus. Flower enthusiasts can also look forward to immersive on-farm experiences, including U-pick events and hands-on floral workshops, giving visitors a rare opportunity to enjoy ultra-fresh flowers right at their source.



This season brings a lineup of engaging on-farm events, including a Spring Kickoff on May 23, flower farmer workshops in June, and U-pick and floral workshops throughout July and August. While the farm is not regularly open to the public, these special events invite guests to experience the charm and serenity of farm life firsthand. HOLIDAY HOURS

The Town Office & Municipal Shop will be closed Monday, May 18 for the Victoria Day holiday.

COUNCIL MEETING DATE CHANGE

The regular Council meeting of May 18 has been rescheduled to May 19 due to Victoria Day.



COMPOST PILE

Spring cleaning will soon be here! Bring yard waste to the Town's Compost Pile located at the Municipal Shop - 5310 48 Ave (follow directional signage). Please do not use this as a dumping ground - take bags and boxes with you.

SPRING STREET SWEEPING

Watch for social media postings and obey posted signs in your neighbourhood for Spring Street Sweeping! Remember to remove your vehicles from the roads to allow the street sweepers to thoroughly clean the streets.

SANITARY SEWER FLUSHING & HYDRANT OPERATION

Public Works will be conducting sewer flushing by setting up equipment at manholes in the roadways to release pressurized water through the sanitary sewer main pipes, removing any buildup. As a result, a bubbling and/or vacuum effect may be noticed in your drains and toilets. If you notice this occurring, we recommend closing all toilet lids and cover floor drains during the flushing period. Also, to prevent sewer gasses from migrating into the home, it is important to refill all plumbing traps by running the water in sinks & floor drains after the work is complete.

Public Works will also be exercising fire hydrants beginning early to mid May. Use caution when on streets and watch for workers and equipment

PARKS & TRAILS

Help keep our parks and trails clean! **Be a responsible pet owner and pick up after your pets.** Pet waste disposal stations are located throughout town along walking trails and near parks and playgrounds.

POND SAFETY

Stay off the surface of the pond! During the spring months it is not safe at anytime for fishing, swimming or walking. Keep an eye on children and keep pets on leashes while around the pond.

BLACK KNOT TREE FUNGUS HOW TO GET RID OF IT

Black Knot is a fungus that can kill a tree in a few years if it's not handled. It is a greenish knot or elongated swelling that forms on twigs and branches and can develop into a black, corky mass that range from about 0.5" to 1.5" in size and may be more than 12" long. You can save your trees by pruning the infected branches. Burn, or wrap the branches in plastic and throw them away in the regular garbage.
