WATER CONSERVATION TIPS

Every drop counts and small changes at home can make a big difference. Here are some easy water-saving tips:

- ⇒ Fix leaks promptly! Dripping taps and leaky toilets waste liters (sometimes gallons) every day.
 - ⇒ Turn off the tap while brushing teeth or washing dishes.
 - ⇒ Run full loads in dishwashers and washing machines
 - ⇒ Take 5-minute showers
 - ⇒ Use a rain barrel to collect water for gardens and lawns
 - ⇒ Choose native or drought-tolerant plants for landscaping

BLACK KNOT TREE FUNGUS

Black Knot is a fungus that can kill a tree in a few years if it's not handled. It is a greenish knot or elongated swelling that forms on twigs and branches and can develop into a black, corky mass that range from about 0.5" to 1.5" in size and may be more than 12" long. You can save your trees by pruning the infected branches. Burn, or wrap the branches in plastic and throw them away in the regular garbage. **DO NOT bring them to the Compost Site.**

PLANNING A RENOVATION?

Before you begin, be aware that some projects require a permit, including Garages, Decks, Fireplaces, Demolitions, Sheds, Seacans, Wood Burning Stoves, and Greenhouses. Visit www.legal.ca for answers to all your development/renovation questions.

CAN I HAVE A PORTABLE TENTED SHELTER?

Yes! However, a development permit IS REQUIRED for any portable tented structure installed in town, and they cannot be located within a front yard. COMMUNITY STANDARDS REMINDERS Bylaw #13-2022

- Grass & Weeds must be kept shorter than 15cm
- Any restricted or noxious weed must be removed to control the spread of these unwanted plants
- Grass in boulevards and rear yards next to back alleys are the responsibility of the property owner or occupant
- Trees and shrubs that grow into back alleys are the responsibility of property owners or occupants - ensure these are cut back or trimmed as to not obstruct passing vehicles
- RV's can be parked in a front or side yard only if on an approved parking pad. Ensure the unit is parked back far enough so that it is not extending over sidewalks or curbs.

INVASIVE WEEDS

It has been noted that some invasive weeds have been seen in and around Legal. It is important to check your property to remove any noxious weeds and if you happen to see these invasive weeds in our parks or in Town, contact the Town of Legal to report them.



BURDOCK

An introduced biennial that forms a rosette of leaves the first year, and large, stout flowering bolt with many branches the second year. It prefers areas with moist fertile soils and recent soil disturbance. Its prickly seed heads are designed for dispersal, readily attaching to whatever animal, human or machine may brush past.

IDENTIFICATION: **Stems** are erect, coarse, branched and thick, have a reddish tinge and may be grooved or angular. Mature plants grow 1-3m tall. **Leaves** are large, hairy, and heart-shaped and readily shade out smaller plants. Stem leaves alternate and are broadest at the stalk. Leaf edges are wavy or toothed. Leaves are woolly on their under sides, and dark green above. **Flowers** are purple and borne in short stalked clusters along the stems. Spiny, hooked bracts surround the florets. **Seeds** start in July and continues into the fall. Seeds are shed continuously throughout the fall, winter and following spring. A mature plant can produce from 6,000 to 16,000 seeds.

PREVENTION: Avoid soil disturbance, re-seed bare soil where possible, encourage desirable, competing vegetation, and don't let existing infestations produce seed. Preventing the production of the burred seed is a key way to prevent spread. Clean burrs off clothing and animals.

CONTROL: Mowing or cutting can eliminate seed production and should be done after the plant has bolted, but before flowering. Some chemicals can also eliminate the plants (visit www.abinvasives.ca for details)



HIMALAYAN BALSAM

Himalayan balsam is a beautiful but highly invasive annual species that quickly overtakes riverbanks, shorelines, and areas with wet soil. Himalayan balsam's rapid growth enables it to produce dense, even-aged stands which shade-out native riparian vegetation, disrupting the food webs of aquatic ecosystems. It then exhibits an impressive growth rate for an annual with some plants growing to 3m tall.

IDENTIFICATION: **Stems** are smooth, hairless, often 4-sided, usually hollow, tinged red-purple and are easily broken. Stems grow 1-3m tall and there may be some branching. **Leaves** are lance shaped or elliptic with pointed tips and rounded bases, and 6-15cm long. The leaves are stalked and have sharply serrated edges. They occur opposite or in whorls of 3. Leaf size decreases with height on the stem. **Flowers** are large (2.5 - 4cm long) in shades of pink through purple, occasionally white. Flowers occur 5-10 together in racemes on long stems borne in the upper leaf axils. Flowers have 5 petals and are bilaterally symmetrical. The upper petal forms a hood over the reproductive structures (resembling a British policeman's helmet) and the lower petals form a platform for landing insects. **Seed** capsules are 1.5-3.5cm long and up to 1.5cm wide and contain up to 16 seeds. Seeds require cold stratification before germination.

PREVENTION: Initial spread is mainly from ornamental plantings, do not purchase, grow, or exchange Himalayan balsam. Reestablishment of native perennial species is key to prevent Himalayan balsam from returning, and control efforts should focus on preventing flowering/seed production. Seed can be spread by movement of riparian soil and in the sediment from the bottoms of water courses of infested areas. Remedy soil disturbance in suitable habitats. Any control work on infested stands must be done before flowering.

CONTROL: Repeated hand-pulling is the most effective and widely used approach. Proper disposal of Himalayan balsam through bagged plant debris should be incinerated or sent to the landfill. Mowing can also be very effective but may need to be repeated. Hedge trimming or brush cutting may be an effective approach to delaying flowering/seed production.
