Today, customers often comment on the shop's warm and welcoming atmosphere, with many reminiscing about the building's past life as a lively bar. The store is filled with treasures, carefully organized, and perhaps most importantly, it's a fun place to shop. Many patrons love the bartering dynamic that has been adopted in the shop and it has been a great learning structure for younger citizens learning purchasing skills. As a donation-based business, Carol's Resale Parlour also offers pickup arrangements for larger items when needed.

Community involvement is at the core of everything they do. In May, Carol's Resale Parlour partnered with Fairydele Blooms to host a well-attended plant and seed swap. They look forward to hosting more Gardener's Socials in the future and will continue offering locally grown bouquets from Fairydele Blooms throughout the growing season. During the town-wide garage sale, they welcomed visitors with complimentary hot dogs, drawing in many shoppers for both lunch and a browse. In June, the shop was also a dedicated stop for "The Run," organized by Gibbons School, and proudly donated backpacks as prizes for several participants and provided cold treats!

Carol's Resale Parlour continues to build strong partnerships within the community, working alongside FCSS locally and Healthy Families out of Westlock to support residents of all ages and needs.

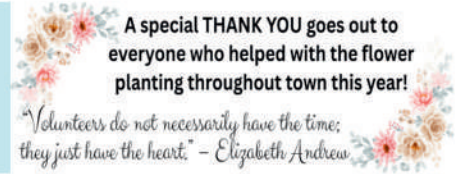

## BUDGET 2026

The Town of Legal Council formally passed the 2026 Capital and Operating Budget on June 1st, 2026, approving an overall 4.48% tax increase. Revenue from other sources is estimated at \$3,314,840 plus \$1,330,302 from collection of property taxes and \$426,979 collected for requisitions equals a total revenue of \$5,072,121 which provides for a balanced budget.

Requisitions include Provincial Education Tax, Homeland Housing Tax and Designated Industrial Property tax. The municipal tax component of the taxes is based on the Town's operating budget requirements. Town Council sets the budget based on service levels for residents and priorities for sustaining and developing our community. To fund the budget, the Town projects revenue from grants, user fees, permits, fines and investments. Any revenue requirement shortfall is obtained through property taxation.

Municipal taxes pay for a range of civic services and programs such as bylaw enforcement, policing costs, administration, firefighting, roads and streets, Family Community Support Services, health and safety, parks and recreation, walking trails, playgrounds, snow removal, street sweeping, sidewalk repairs, recreational facilities, community events, streetlights and other various services.

Property taxes include the provincial educational tax, which is determined by the Alberta Government (GoA) based on the Town of Legal's share of the provincial education tax requirement. **The Town does not set or control education taxes.**

There is no revenue which comes to the Town from education taxes collected, it is simply forwarded to the GoA. The Homeland Housing tax is collected & forwarded for funding of senior's housing operated by Homeland Housing. **The Town does not set or control the tax amount.** This tax is set in March of each year.

**The GoA imposed an increase of 11.4 % increase in Alberta School requisitions** for 2026 when compared to 2025.

A residential property assessed at \$300,460 would see an estimated increase in taxes of **\$162.67** for 2026, of which 60% (**\$97.60**) is a result of **Education tax increase** and the remainder **\$65.07 funds municipal operations.**

Capital expenditures for 2026 were kept at a minimum amounting to \$82,000. The Town's desire was to stack and reallocate the 2026 grant allocations (approximately \$480,000) to 2027. When combining the 2026 and 2027 grant allocation, it is expected approximately \$900,000 of funding will be available, which will allow the Town to leverage better pricing and complete larger scale projects. It is anticipated that funding will be applied to sidewalk and road rehabilitation and walking trail improvements.



## PREVENT BASEMENT FLOODING DURING HEAVY RAIN



The municipal wastewater system was overloaded as a result of the infiltration of storm water from sump pumps & weeping tile systems. Did you know that homes built post 1983 cannot have sump pumps or weeping tiles discharging stormwater into the Town's sanitary system. **Please do your part:**

- Clear eavestroughs & downspouts of debris to ensure proper water flow away from your home.
- Check sump pumps to confirm they are working and have a backup power source if possible.
- Install backflow valves to prevent sewer backup damage.
- Fill in any cracks or holes in your foundation or concrete around your home, and make sure your weeping tile is draining properly.
- Clean out window wells
- Use rain barrels to help collect water
- Ensure Positive Drainage is in place - The grade of your yard should slope away from your home (so water will drain away from the foundation).
